

## **Curriculum Pathways**



A multi-disciplinary team will assess a young person's needs, abilities and aspirations to ensure they are placed on the learning pathway suitable for them as an individual. A rationale will be created to ensure clear justification for this and is agreed up by all. Continual review and assessment of learning will ensure a young person is able to access the most appropriate pathway for them at that time. A young person may move onto new pathways as their needs change.
